ACCEPTABLE SOURCES: Popular magazines or newspapers (Time, Newsweek, US News and World Report, New York Times, Wall Street Journal), criminal justice periodicals (ProQuest), law review articles (LexisNexis), television documentaries.

UNACCEPTABLE SOURCES: Short articles, reports of individual crimes, biographies of criminals or law enforcement officers.
